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**Travel and Accommodations:** The cost of travel and accommodations can vary greatly depending upon the cost of airfare at the time and the family's preferences regarding accommodation and experiences. The estimates below are based on an average cost of travel. For families seeking more luxuries in their travel experience the cost could be considerably higher. Families who can stay with family or friends in Jamaica during travel may pay considerably less than the estimates. (96.40(c)(2))

<b>Airfare</b>	Approx. \$400/per person round trip + \$300/per child one-way trip = \$1,100 for 2 adults, 1 child

**Third-Party Fees:** Third party fees encompass the expected total fees and estimated expenses for services that the prospective adoptive parent(s) will be responsible to pay directly to a third-party, other than those fees already listed above. Such third-party fees include, but are not limited to, fees to competent authorities for services rendered or Central Authority processing fees. (96.40(c)(1))

\* Families who receive an Adoption License and whose child enters the U.S. on an IR-4 visa will be responsible for completing a N600 application with USCIS after finalization to apply for the child's U.S. Certificate of Citizenship.

*Fees not paid directly to Adoption by Shepherd Care (ASC) will vary in cost based on your specific situation and may vary depending on the exchange rate at the time. Such fees will include USCIS fees, visas, transportation, accommodations, medical and other necessary adoption-related expenses.*

## DEFINITIONS/EXPLANATIONS

**Application/Consultation/Orientation Fee:** This ASC fee is provided for in the United States. *96.40(b)(2)*. This fee is due with the application and is for the services of reviewing the application and providing consultation and orientation to the family.

**IAAME Monitoring & Oversight Fee:** This IAAME fee is provided for in the United States. *96.40(b)(2)*. This fee is due with the signed Adoption Services Contract. This fee goes directly to ASC for distribution to third-party, the Intercountry Adoption Accreditation and Maintenance Entity (“IAAME”). IAAME is the accrediting entity that accredits, monitors, and oversees Hague Accredited agencies. The family is responsible for a fee of \$850 per child referred. The additional amount will be charged after the family accepts the referral(s) of more than one child.

**ASC Agency Fee:** This is a fee that is paid in the United States and goes directly to ASC for the provision of adoption services other than the home study and/or post-placement or post-adoption report. The category of fees includes but is not limited to 1) agency personnel in the US, 2) operational costs, 3) maintaining Hague compliance, 4) administrative overhead, 5) communications, 6) ongoing case management, 7) support during waiting time, 8) coordination of referral information, and 9) assistance with various pre-travel requirements including USCIS requirements. *96.40(b)(2)*.

**Jamaica Program Fee:** ASC does not collect fees to be distributed to Jamaica for adoption services provided in-country. *96.40(f)*. *96.40(b)(3)*. This fee is not applicable in Jamaica.

**Dossier Processing Fee:** This is a fee paid in the United States and goes directly to ASC for assistance in compiling dossier documents according to CPFSA guidelines and review of dossier prior to submission. *96.40(b)(2)*.

**Home Study Fee:** This fee is paid in the United States to either ASC (for Florida families) or a third-party home study preparer. The fee includes providing instruction on the completion of a home study, reviewing documents submitted, home visits, and drafting the home study assessment. *96.40(b)(1)*.

- For Florida families completing their home study with ASC, the family will be charged Federal Mileage for the distance between the ASC office and the family’s home. These fees will be paid directly to ASC for families completing the home study with ASC. Hourly amount of \$50/hour for travel time with no charge for the 3<sup>rd</sup> hour.
  - Criminal incident fee of \$350 per incident, for review and evaluation of suitability in light of incident(s)
- For families **not** completing their home study with ASC, the cost of the home study will vary depending on the home study preparer used. The approximate range of home study services is \$2,000 - \$4,000. The family will pay the third-party home study preparer directly for the services provided. The home study preparer will be an exempted provider of ASC. The cost for ASC to review the home study prepared by an exempted provider is \$500. Where the home study is not completed in the first instance by a Hague Accredited provider, ASC will be responsible for the review and Hague approval of the home study in accordance with 96.47(c).
- Additional fees that may apply:
  - Home Study Update: \$2,000 for Florida families completing the home study with ASC. Travel time and mileage rates apply.
  - Home Study Rush Fee: \$500 paid prior to start of home study. A rush home study is one completed within 8 weeks, provided the family is able to submit all required documentation to ASC in that timeframe.

**Home Study Addendum / Response to Request for Evidence (RFE) or Additional Information:** This fee is paid in the United States to ASC (for Florida families) and/or a third-party home study preparer. \$500-\$1,500 per request, depending on the nature of the request and amount of work required. This applies to situations where USCIS or Jamaica requests more information or evidence related to your international home study or other documents after they have been submitted. This includes but is not limited to requests for evidence related to the I600A, I600, requests from Jamaica, and requests during the visa process.

**Translation and Document Fee:** Documents sent to and from Jamaica are in English; therefore, no translation fees apply.

**Post-Placement Report Refundable Deposit:** For non-Florida families, this amount is to be paid by the family as a deposit to ensure timely completion of post-placement reporting requirements. Once the adoption has finalized, ASC will refund the full deposit within thirty (30) days of receipt of all required documents.

**Post-Adoption/ Post-Placement Report Fee:** This fee is paid in the United States to ASC for the services associated with one post-adoption report (for Order cases) or three post-placement reports (for License cases). 96.40(b)(7). For families that do not have their post-adoption or post-placement reports completed by ASC, the family will pay this approximate amount to local agency for the completion of the post-adoption or post-placement reports.

- Fee is \$650 per post visit for sibling groups of two. Fee for additional siblings assessed case by case.

**Finalization of the Adoption / Re-Adoption Fee:** This fee is paid in the United States to ASC for services associated with finalizing the adoption (License cases) or completing a re-adoption (Order cases) of the child in Florida. The fee includes ASC's preparation fee, attorney services, court filing fee, and certified copies of Florida Birth Certificate.

**Third Party Fees:** The additional fees for which the adopting parents will be responsible for are outlined herein and separated by the additional third-party fees to be paid directly by the adopting family in the United States and in Jamaica. 96.40(c)(1).

**Travel and Accommodation:** The fees for travel, accommodations, and meals are paid directly by the adopting parents to third parties. The costs associated with travel can depend greatly on a variety of factors including, but not limited to, time of year, length of time before travel is required, and preferences for accommodations/travel/meals. 96.40(c)(2)).

**Care of the Child:** In Jamaica, no fees go to CPFSA or any other organization caring for the referred child(ren). There are no fees for costs of caring for the child, food, clothing, shelter, medical care, or any other services provided to the child required to be paid by the adopting family prior to placement. 96.40(b)(4). This fee is not applicable in Jamaica. However, if the family seeks additional medical testing or medical care based on a specific child's medical condition or medical need, the fees associated with those additional services and care would be the responsibility of the adopting family.

**Contribution:** In Jamaica there is no fixed amount or percentage that the family will be expected or required to make to any child protection program. 96.40(b)(6). This fee is not applicable in Jamaica.

**Special Services:** ASC does not utilize any part of its fees as outlined herein to provide special services, such as cultural programs for adoptees, scholarships, or other services. 96.40(e). This fee is not applicable in Jamaica.

### **PAYMENT OF FEES AND REFUND POLICY**

Fees will be charged by ASC in accordance with this fee schedule. Fees may be paid by credit card, money order, wire transfer or check made out to Adoption by Shepherd Care. 96.40(a). I/We understand that all funds applied to any services rendered listed above are non-refundable unless otherwise provided herein, whether or not the adoption is finalized. There are no other circumstances in which fees or expenses will be waived, reduced, or refunded. (96.40(a)).

It is the policy and practice of ASC not to customarily charge additional fees and expenses beyond those disclosed herein as part of the Adoption Services Contract. If unforeseen additional fees and expenses are incurred in Jamaica, ASC would only charge such additional fees and expenses under the following conditions:

1. It discloses the fees and expenses in writing to the prospective adoptive parent(s); (96.40(g)(1))
2. It obtains the specific consent of the prospective adoptive parent(s) prior to expending any funds in excess of \$1,000 for which the agency or person will hold the prospective adoptive parent(s) responsible or gives the prospective adoptive parent(s) the opportunity to waive the notice and consent requirement in advance. If the prospective adoptive parent(s) has the opportunity to waive the notice and consent requirement in advance, this policy is reflected in the written policies and procedures of the agency or person; (96.40(g)(2) and
3. It provides written receipts to the prospective adoptive parent(s) for fees and expenses paid directly by the agency or person in the foreign country and retains copies of such receipts. (96.40(g)(3))

If either party decides to withdraw from this adoption plan, I/we, the prospective adoptive parents, are aware that we are responsible for all fees through the day of termination. ASC will conduct an expense analysis at the close of the case to determine refunds to which the adopting parents may be entitled. Where any funds are advanced to cover fees or expenses not yet provided, such funds will be refunded via wire transfer or check mailed to the family within sixty (60) days of the completion of services (96.40(d)). All funds due to the adopting family shall be returned within sixty (60) days of completion of the delivery of services. Refunds may be provided via check or wire transfer (96.40(h)).

By signing below, I hereby acknowledge having received this fee schedule prior to the submission of my/our formal application to ASC (96.40(a)). I understand the expected total fees and estimated expenses as well as the conditions under which fees or expenses may be charged, waived, reduced or refunded, and of how and when fees must be paid (96.40(a)).
